(GANA KIRITHARAN'S ATTEMPT TO BECOME A FREELANCE WRITER, FRAUDULENT INTERFERENCES HE EXPERIENCED AND HIS ATTEMPT TO DEFEND HIMSELF.)

I, Gana Kiritharan, of City of Toronto, of Province of Ontario, the Plaintiff in this action,

MAKE OATH AND SAY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Around 1993, while I was studying Medicine in Sri Lanka (which is my native country), I developed an idea of writing books in field of Sociology and wish to improve knowledge in that field. But the ethnic problem in Sri Lanka and various personal challenges prevented me from starting my work immediately. (Pages 5, 6, 7)
- 2. I migrated to India as a Refugee around 1997. I found a job as an Administrative Assistant in a Hospital and studied Sociology, Management and Computer Applications. I decided to write my first book about "Total Quality Management". (Pages 8, 9, 10, 11, 12)
- 3. While in India I also read lots of books about history. From my readings I was able to understand the challenges faced my past scientist to improve knowledge. From this, I understand my attempt to improve knowledge not going to be a cake walk.
- 4. I migrated to Ottawa Canada as a Refugee in 1999 February. As my foreign degree and experience were not recognized by Canadian Society I started to work as an Assembler in Fibro Optic production line. (Pages 13)
- 5. Around September 1999, I made some intellectual contribution for Quality of Production of the Fibro Optic Company I worked, but Company failed to appreciate my contribution. This was my first direct experience with racial discrimination (Pages 10 16 of Affidavit of Document 4 Civil).

- 6. Around 2000 February (in Ottawa) I changed my job from assembler to security guard and started to write my first book.
- 7. I failed to receive help on proof reading for my book from my cousin Ms. Mathurika Rasaratnum (from UK). Though she gave me a previous promise and stated to help me happily, she stopped with first 11 chapters and I had to search for new help to do the rest of the work.
- 8. On 14th of January 2001, for the book publication ceremony at a restaurant in Ottawa, the invited people failed to show up on time. When function started with 6 people, restaurant owner received Telephone calls and answered "Yes, it is going on; Yes, it is going on." Then four more friends of mine joined the function.
- 9. My family friend Mr. S. Ganesalingan (from India) failed to print the book in mass scale on time and the book I received after few months delay contained several mistakes and can not be sold in the market. (Pages 14, 15)

10. I realized some intentional actions were the cause of my failure, but initially I thought it was a pure family issue.

- 11. I received help in Proof reading of my book from my friend Mr. Mohammad Hashemi in Ottawa and printed 100 books in good print and started distribution of my book. I started to receive order for my book from quality professionals in Ottawa and decided to start a business.
- 12. As I was in unemployment at that time (March 2001 December 2001), I applied for Self-Employment Benefit program around September 2001 but failed to get selected for the program. When I went for a review about application I received a verbal promise from program coordinators (Ottawa YMCA) that if I reapply for the program I will be selected. (Page 16)
- 13. I searched and find a publisher in India (UBSPD) to publish my book, but experienced missing and delayed mails from my publisher. (Pages 18, 19)
- 14. Around 2002 November I reapplied for the Self-Employment Benefit program but failed to get selected for the program again. (Page 17)

15. I realized the challenges I was facing were created by a well organized group of people.

- 16. I decided to not to challenge the group immediately, as I was a landed immigrant who was waiting for the citizenship and I was signed my publishing contract but my book not released into market. I afraid any legal proceeding may interfere above two procedures.
- 17. Around October December 2002 I realized my personal communications and telephone communications were being recorded with an intention to benefit from my intellectual works. (Page 17 22 of affidavit of Document 4 Civil.)

- 18. Around February May 2003 I made my comments about Iraq war, immediately after I experienced some neurological symptoms in my body.
- 19. From October 2003 February 2004 I visited India and made some book promotions and returned to Toronto.
- 20. After returning from India I started to challenge the group who was harassing me. I started to say I will sue any body who was interfering into my writing career for 3 million a year, which is my targeted income.
- 21. Around April 2004 the Incident of Forgery happens in my Equifax Credit Report. (Affidavit of Document 6 Civil.)
- 22. When checking on Internet I found out my book is illegally printed and distributed. I brought this to the attention of my publishers, but they failed to give a responsible reply. (Pages 3 9 of Affidavit of Document 4 Civil)
- 23. Around October 2004 In Toronto I was denied work for 8 consecutive working days by my employment agency. As a result my financial situation collapse and I stop payment for most of my creditors. (Page 20)
- 24. Immediately after I denied work, I started to search for Lawyers to defend myself from the challenges I was facing. In the afternoon of my first visit to a lawyer's office, I received call from my employment agency and offered work.
- 25. Between October 2004 March 2005, When I went for regular banking at TD Canada Trust Branches in Scarborough the incident of printing additional information in Transaction Records (Slips) happened. (Affidavit of Document 1 Civil.)
- 26. Around October November 2004, I failed to find a lawyer to defend myself. I was unable to pay the money demanded by lawyers. When I went for legal aid office, at the reception I was informed legal aid is not available for my case.
- 27. Around December 2004, I decided to search for wider help for my situation. I typed my experiences in Canada into a document format and send it to few people in Canada. Also I send the document to my friends in India and Sri Lanka. I also send the document to my publishers in India.
- 28. Around March 2005, I decided to leave Canada for a long time. I shipped my important reference books and other materials to India and left Canada.
- 29. Around April July 2005, I failed to establish myself in India. The money provided as royalty for my book work not enough for my personal living in India.
- 30. Around June July 2005, I prepared the Incident Experienced by me and available evidence in to a document format and send it to three Tamil news papers and three English News dailies in Canada. I also gave the document to Tamil National leaders in Chennai, India.

- Around August 2005, I decided and returned to Sri Lanka. I requested financial help and a public recognition for my contribution to Sri Lankan Tamil community from my friends.
- 32. Around August December 2005, I failed to receive any financial help from my friends. While I was staying in a Hospital at Kilinochchi – Sri Lanka, I realized a cinema production group came from South India to Sri Lanka was recording my personal activity.
- 33. Around January March 2006, In Sri Lanka I sold a piece of land which I received from my ancestors to solve my financial problem. Also I made donation of another piece from above land for one of my family worker.
- 34. Around March 2006, As I lost my Sri Lankan citizenship when I become a Canadian Citizen I faced some problem in staying in Sri Lanka for longer periods. I returned to India. I also started to make arrangement to apply for a dual citizenship in Sri Lanka.
- Around May 2006, though initially I was planning to return to Sri Lanka, as the Civil war in Sri Lanka started I retuned to Canada.
- 36. In August 2006, I ordered and received my TransUnion Credit Report. When analyzing it in December 2006 I found my Line of Credit with TD Canada Trust reported as "Balance 0.00, Closed on Consumer Request."
- 37. Around September 2006 the movie "Aanivaer" (Taproot or Phoenix) released around the World. I realized the Director of the film Mr. John Mahendiran is the person who was recording my personal activity in a Hospital in Sri Lanka and the story of the Movie may be based on events in my personal life. Gana Kiritharan get informed by Mr. John Mahendran (Auther and Director of the Movie Aanivaer) that his beleive about the Movie is not True. For Details Information Please Refer Affidavit of Document 12 Civil.
- I tried to communicate with TD Canada Trust regarding my concerns between 2007 March and October 2007. But failed to receive responsible explanation from the bank. (Affidavit of Document 3 Civil).
- 39. On 18th October 2008, I filed my civil claim in Ontario civil Court.
- 40. I, Gana Kiritharan, believe, if I did not experience above mentioned fraudulent interference into my intellectual life and financial life and allowed to become a freelance writer under the civilized concepts of Rule of Law and Free Market Economy, today I will be making at least One Billion Canadian Dollars per Year (CAD \$ 1,000,000,000.000 per Year)

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Although 'Do' and 'Act' may look similar, Deming differentiates between them; Deming suggests that the 'do' stage is used to implement small - scale planned changes. In this stage small tests should be conducted and the data collected. The data should be checked and resources should be organized for successful implementation. What Deming has tried to do is replace the 'Organization' function with a more practical and experimental 'Do' function.

In chapter one, 'Introduction' I listed seven different functions in quality management. Is there a similar cycle here? Although there is a relationship, there are no strict rules that define this relationship. Quality management requires jumping from one action to another and sometimes concentrating on particular actions depending on the situation within the company. The following diagram gives some possible relationships between the different functions of quality management with some equivalent general management functions.




Fig.4.5.Quality Management Cycle.

Philip.B.Crosby starts his book "Quality without Tears" with the following, "When a physician sees a patient with red spots, a fever, and a brother who has measles, it is not necessary to be Louis Pasture to make a diagnosts." In many instances, within his writing, Crosby compares the functioning of the human body with similar situations inside organizations to explain problems and provide solutions. As someone from the medical profession I would like to elaborate the analogy and try and explain some quality management functions.




