Thank you for your letter dated February 19, 2010, with attached documents addressed to the Attorney General of Ontario. Your correspondence has been forwarded to this office for a response.

In your letter you request that the Attorney General call a public inquiry to investigate how your case was treated by the judiciary in the civil courts. Please note that this is not within the Attorney General's mandate. One of the fundamental principles of our justice system is that the judiciary is independent and must be free to make decisions in court without any control or influence exerted by parties outside the judicial system, including government officials. A private lawyer would be in the best position to advise you about your rights and obligations in these circumstances.
